## Special Editorial May 2009

As most of you know by now the proposed county budget cuts for the Butte County Library system will reduce the number of hours for the Chico branch to 12 a week. **That's 12 hours a week!** This is unacceptable to all members of our community. While it seems impossible, it could be a reality. Already the branch is without an Adult Services Reference Librarian, the Children's Room programs no longer exist and the Children's Librarian has been relieved of her duties. However, the worse scenario as painted by Derek Wolfgram, the country librarian, is that all but two staff will be laid off, all programs will be cut, the community room will only be open during library hours of operation, there will be a discontinuance of newspapers, periodicals subscriptions and no new acquisitions of books and other media. The only staff assistance will be at the circulation desk the two days a week that the library will be open. At the county level such programs as the Literacy Van, Branch Book Loans and other services will stop and costs for other services such as Interlibrary Loan borrowing will increase.
