A new task is posted on our Facebook every Sunday at 5:00pm. You will have all week to complete the task. Can we count on you?

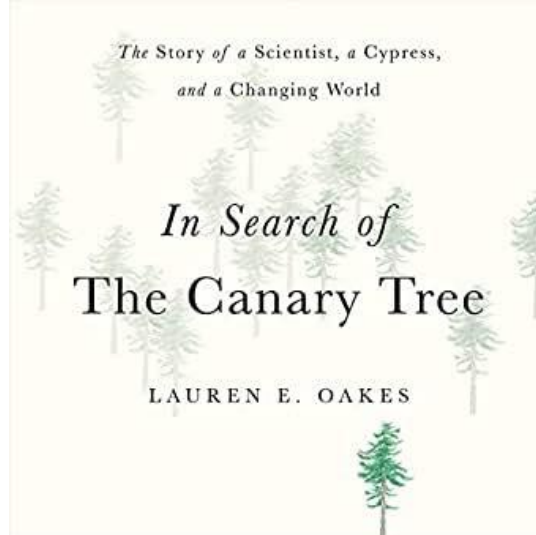
