CFOL Library Advocacy Issues and Involvement:

Funding from the City of Chico was decreased by 7 hours to cover only 18 extra open hours.

Funding from Butte County has remained stable at the reduced number of 30 hours. Distribution of Planned Giving Brochures printed for the Butte County Library Advisory Board

CFOL provided partial financial support for a countywide poll of likely voters. Results: Library users will support additional libraryfunding. However, there are not enough library users countywide to pass a library measure. Of those surveyed, 22% (mostly young renters) were fairly unaware of the library.

Involved in countywide drive to increase Library Card Holders by 10,000 and also increase membership for Friends groups: Booths at Butte College Roadrunner Market, other markets, Barnes & Noble Book Fair, and other events throughout county.
