Library Advisory Board: Don reported LAB meeting and a 6-hour training session which hopefully made the group more cohesive. Outcome in a few months will be new bylaws. Sustainable Funding is still the goal, but few ideas about how to achieve it. Diane Friedman resigned from the LAB, so there is another opening for the Chico area. Discussion continued regarding the Love Your Library efforts toward new library revenue, downturn in the economy, and loss of enthusiasm.

Librarian: Service for Rob Atkinson will be at the Card Center, time announced next week. Daughter of library courier service driver died in car accident recently. Linda Mielke, Butte

County Library Director has resigned effective Nov. 1. She is taking a job in New York. She has been a great asset for our library system.
