  - Brenda Crotts for Lydia. Changes in Children's and Teen areas. Thanks for the CARD ad. Summer Reading programs are set. <u>Board approved amount for Summer Reading programs to be about \$1200 (m/s/c Elliott/Friedman).</u>
  - Brenda Crotts. See attached report from Brenda. All story times are popular; outgrowing children's room and will occasionally use meeting room instead. 28 people at Gravity movie. Hunger Games and Frozen next. Do not announce movie titles outside of library (i.e., Carrel, Internet, ChicoER, etc.) due to license restrictions. ... Class visits have been happening. Lydia has been doing school outreach. ... New computers are in IS and being prepared. 15 public Internet stations, 3 Children's ... Many changes in item locations go take a tour. ... When PCs come, they will be setup in a new printing situation costing about \$2580. It's a free standing unit where patrons pay before printing service contract included software included "Everything" included, according to Mel. No motion was made to approve the printer situation. Timer will be part of the setup don't know if the timers are part of the \$2580 or not. Need more information. Have we already approved this as part of the approval for the PCs?

We don't have a lot of spare cash in checking, and we don't have to think about it right away, so vote not made. For April, 2014, meeting: Tour the library and hear about the proposed changes, receive accurate proposal, and vote. Start at 6pm, take tour, continue the meeting.

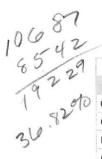
