ONGOING/NEWS BUSINESS:

At the June 17, 2014, City council budget meeting, the **city council voted to reduce funding by \$25,000, 25%, from \$100K to \$75K.** Melanie has done some contingency planning ... Monday costs about \$72K. Six city-funded, early hours may go away (Tues-Wed-Thurs). Melanie sees no staff cuts; however, might have to cut extra hours. Decision lies w/Butte County board of supervisors.

We discussed a motion to fund the library up to \$12,500, but the motion was not passed (no vote). We decided to let the BC Board of Sup's deal with the problem before we do anything. (Note: A day or two after this board meeting, the County's Financial Officer, Paul Hahn, and the Board of Supervisors decided to continue hours and staff with no cuts until the City's \$75K runs out. In the meantime, Mr. Hahn will work with Chico City financial staff to try and fund the missing \$25K.)

Mohammed Khaki was introduced as possible financial advisor to follow Gerald Davis and to act as liaison to Stifel Nicolaus, our local investment firm. He has not prepared income tax returns (Gerald had). He was chair of finance committee at Notre dame school. He is a retired professor and financial advisor. And, he is willing to help in any way he can.
