A motion to purchase four more Kindles for approximately \$1,000 was m/s/c. Bomberg, Kidd.

A gift to honor Gerald Davis for his many contributions to the library was discussed. Ann and Marian offered to head the search for a bench to replace the one in the library lobby, approximately \$1,000 to be provided by CFOL (m/s/c Bomberg, Kidd) An appropriate plaque will be included.

Mohammed Khaki was introduced. He has agreed to assist the board as a financial advisor, a role previously filled by Gerald Davis.

The board was reminded of the Annie B. community drive, beginning Aug. 1. (It will continue through Sept. 30.) CFOL membership dues may be paid through this drive.

Kidd asked for more promotion of jigsaw puzzle sales. They were produced as a fund raiser and there is still a large supply.

A discussion was held about possible ways to promote the value of the library as a community asset to both the Chico City Council and to the Finance Committee. One proposal is a quarterly letter from the CFOL president, Friedman.

Marian Milling asked members to keep July 29th open to attend a lunch for Fe Howard in appreciation for her many years of contributions to the Chico Library.
